DESCRIPTION:

The City of Torrance Community Services Department is currently accepting applications for Community Services Leader III to assist at the Madrona Marsh Preserve and Nature Center as an Animal Care Volunteer.

The Madrona Marsh Preserve is the last remaining freshwater marsh in Los Angeles County. Within the approximately 45 acres, there are over 250 species of plants and 265 species of birds that use the Preserve during migration. The Nature Center Programs are designed to increase public awareness and promote environmental education and other nature/conservation related issues.

The **CSL III** will assist in the daily cleaning of exhibits, preparing diets, feeding animals, observing animals, record keeping, providing enrichment and are responsible for keeping all animal areas clean and disinfected. Some occasional public speaking and animal handling is required.

Job Duties & Responsibilities

The following duties represent the principal job duties; however, they are not all inclusive.

- Preparing diets and feeding animals;
- · Cleaning animal enclosures and or holding areas;
- · Observing animals' behavior;
- Record keeping;
- Organizing animal care supplies and cleaning food prep areas;
- Occasional public speaking;
- Other duties as required.

Hours: This is a recurrent, part-time, non-civil service, as needed position. Hours are approximately XX hours per week. This position will be expected to be available to work most weekends year-round, including most holidays.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from High School or equivalent and one year of recent part-time work experience directly related to recreation or community programs and services.

- Comfortable working with tortoises, turtle, snake's and amphibians;
- Leadership ability to oversee volunteers working in the Marsh and Nature Center.
- Public speaking and teaching skills;
- Proficient in Microsoft Suite, social media and internet research;
- Ability to write professional reports on nature and volunteer programs;
- A passion for nature and the outdoors.
